THE DIFFERENCE:

Key groundbreaking ingredients in each product are encapsulated in patented microscopic liposome spheres—Remergent's signature technology—that have been proven in large-scale clinical testing to deliver their contents exactly where needed: at the cellular level. The advanced ingredients contain both preventive and reparative elements, providing protection and restoration to the skin.

THE INGREDIENTS:



Photosomes. Liposomes encapsulating a DNA repair enzyme derived from ocean plankton that is unique in its proven ability to harness light energy to improve the appearance of sun-damaged skin.



Ultrasomes. Liposomes engineered to carry an extract from a marine microbe that intensifies the skin's ability to repair sun-inflicted DNA damage, speeding recovery, and—as a bonus—reducing the appearance of post-sunburn peeling.



Roxisomes. Liposomes encapsulating a repair enzyme isolated from a tiny mustard plant that has been shown to protect the cell's genetic material from free radical damage. Roxisomes aid in the removal of oxidation both in the cell's nucleus and its energy-generating mitochondria.



THE INGREDIENTS:



Thiotaine. A potent and stable lab-formulated rendering of a botanical amino acid, shown to promote skin energy and block the activation of two enzymes, elastase and matrix metalloproteinases (MMPs), which degrade collagen and elastin, and destroy the skin's supporting structure—leading to wrinkle formation.



Evodio. A biomimetic transcription of the ancient Chinese pain elixir Wu-Zhu-Yu (evodia fruit), known to curb irritation and soothe aggravated skin. In clinical studies, the active components from this fruit have been shown to inhibit inflammation and reduce stress.



Vitamin C and Vitamin E (in oil-soluble form). Vitamin C, essential for stimulating collagen production, accompanied by vitamin E, its natural regenerating partner. The two work in tandem to maintain vital antioxidant levels.

Broad-spectrum **Avobenzone (Parsol 1789)**, combined with UVB sunscreens, to protect against the photo-aging effects of the sun.

USAGE:

Apply one metered dose of **DNA Repair Formula** to face and another to arms and throat after A.M. and P.M. cleansing. Follow morning application with **A.M. Moisturizer SPF 15**. Immediately after exfoliation, following application of **DNA Repair Formula**, apply one metered dose of **Antioxidant Refoliator** to treated area in the evening.
